Six Sons and a Seismograph—the story of George Hogben (1853–1920)

George Hogben was not only an educator as a teacher (1881 – 1889) and Inspector general of schools (1889 - 1915) and founder of NZEI, he was also NZs first systematic seismologist and internationally acknowledged. He was also the brother in law of Julius von Haast, 2IC of Christchurch Boys High in 1881, 2nd principal of Timaru High school, 1st principal of Timaru Boys High school. George married Emily Dobson (yes, youngest daughter of Edward Dobson) in 1885, and they had 6 sons. Their story is one of Victorian tragedy and triumph and a legacy that we still live with today.

After retirement from secondary school teaching Dr Glenn Vallender became interested in the history of geoscience in NZ. Glenn has a lifetime passion for geoscience education and with the generosity of the Canterbury History Foundation has recently published a book on the history of the Christchurch Magnetic Observatory. This book is available from the Botanic Gardens Visitor Centre with all profits assisting with the maintenance of the remaining workshop museum.
