Raymond Herber has turned the beautiful setting of the Amberley Lime Quarry into a landscaped exhibition space for his creations, mostly worked from steel. There are also sculptures from other Canterbury artists. The visit includes a forging demonstration by Raymond as well as tea or coffee.
