At our July meeting Dr Peter Field gave a very thought-provoking talk on understanding the influence of religion in the United States of America. Dr Field, Head of the School of Humanities and Creative Art at the University of Canterbury is an American who has lived in Canterbury for 20 years. He, in a written brief prior to speaking described his speech, and I quote, "America and religion is a complex issue. Yet it's Founding was decidedly secular. Today there is a



great divide between religious (Right) and the agnostic (Left). Yet paradoxically, the Right seem to be devotees of the Founding and the Left seem to manifest traits some have compared to religious enthusiasm."

Dr Field's presentation certainly challenged all about their beliefs and it was the motivation for further discussion after the meeting about trying to understand America's Right and Left and their motives for being so fanatical about politics.
